Weather Policy:

We do not cancel dove shoots due to weather forecast unless it is severe weather such as a hurricane, at that point we will make up the shoot at another date. If it's calling for rain bring rain gear. If a thunderstorm comes into the area we simply go inside or sit in vehicles until it passes and then add time lost at the end of the afternoon.

What to bring:

Shotgun and 4 boxes of shells #7 ½ or #8 per person. Shotguns must be plugged holding 3 shells max.

Va. Hunting license and HIP registration.

Cooler, ice, drinks and lunch/snacks for field, sunscreen. **No alcohol allowed until you are done hunting and have put your firearm away for the day.**

Dove bucket, stool or chair.

Well behaved dogs welcome.

PICKING SPOTS: Check in will begin at 10:00am. Hunters will draw numbers for their spots. Spots are 75-100 yards apart. There will be 2 hunters per spot with room for the hunters to spread 15-20 yards apart. Our farms are located throughout eastern Prince Edward Co. and some spots will require hunters to drive to their spot after registering.


All hunting will end at approximately 5:30 pm.

DOVE SHOOT RULES

- 1. All shoots start at 12 noon.
- 2. Follow all game laws. Plugs in autos and pumps. Have your license and HIP number on you at all times. 15 bird limit, any bird killed counts towards your limit whether you find it or not.
- 3. NO LOW BIRDS!!!!! Barrel must be a 30 degrees or higher.



- 4. Shooting is done from your hunting area only, not while retrieving birds.
- 5. #7.5 shot or smaller (8-9) only.
- 6. No alcohol on fields. Once you have an adult beverage, you are done hunting for the day.
- 7. Keep gun pointed in safe direction at all times. Be aware of the water buggies or trucks; please no shooting when they are close to you.
- 8. If any rules are broken, we have the right to ask you to leave without a refund.
- 9. If you see hunters breaking the rules or being dangerous please make us aware of the problem ASAP. Waiting till the end of the day doesn't do anyone any good. Chris McClellan cell 434-603-2803.
